In cities across the United States, YLAI Fellows gain valuable professional development skills and experience at U.S. entrepreneurial organizations from each Fellow's business sector. Fellows collaborate with their fellowship host on their Entrepreneurial Leadership Action Plan (E-LAP), which they will implement upon return to their home countries.



POST-FELLOWSHIP SUSTAINED ENGAGEMENT:


